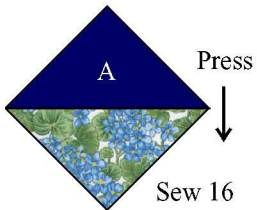

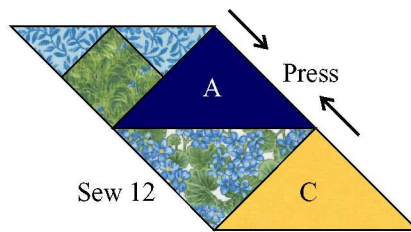


BACKING~ 1-1/2 yards of either the Tea Cup print 105992 or if you want your quilting to stand out use the solid golden yellow 105702

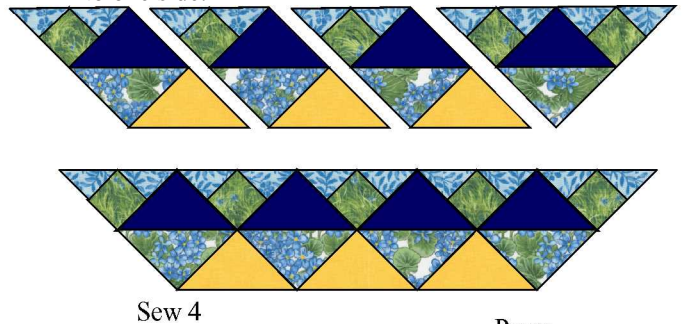
1- Sew sixteen A/B units. Press the seam allowances toward B.



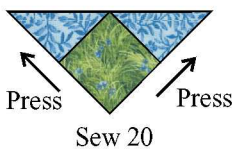
3- Sew twelve units together as shown below. Press the seam allowances in the direction indicated by the arrows.



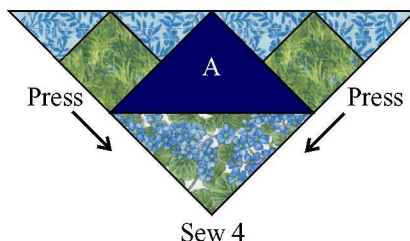
5- Sew the units into four rows. Press all seam allowances to one side.



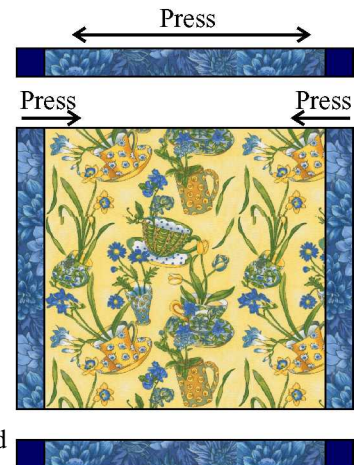
2- Sew twenty E/D/E units. Press the seam allowances toward the E triangles.



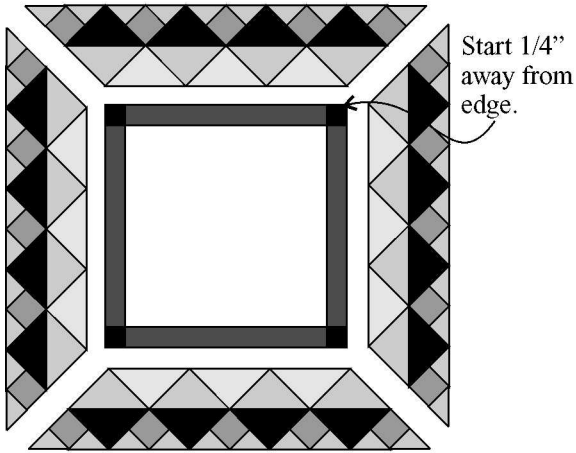
4- Sew four units together as shown below. Press the seam allowances in the direction indicated by the arrows.



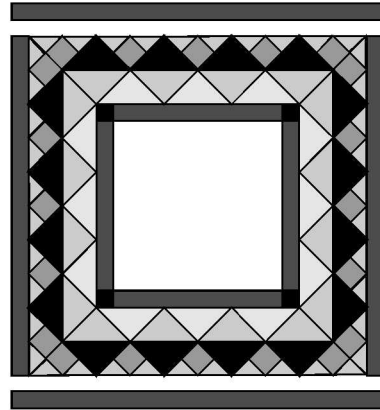
6- Sew the corner squares to each end of two of the border 1 strips. Press seam allowances toward the corner squares. Sew a border 1 strip to each side of the medallion square. Press seam allowances toward the medallion. Sew the border/corner square strips to the top and bottom of the medallion. Press toward the medallion.



- 7- Sew the rows to the medallion/border section. Start the stitches 1/4" away from the edges of the medallion section. Press away from the medallion.
- 8- Sew the corner seams matching the piecework as you go. Press seam allowances to one side.



- 9- Sew the border 2 strips to the quilt top. Press the seam allowances toward border 2.
- 10- Sew a B corner square to each end of two border 3 strips. Sew the border 3 strips to the quilt top. Press the seam allowances toward border 3.
- 11- Layer the quilt backing wrong side up, batting and then the quilt top, right side up together. Baste the layers to secure.



- 12- Quilting suggestions include daffodil or tulip designs complement the focal prints design. We quilted an all-over tulip design in the medallion center square, separate tea cup motifs tossed throughout the pieced border and a tulip border design in the outer border.
